Footnotes

PALONIAN EXPRESS prompted the pace racing nearest the rail, forged clear into the stretch and widened her advantage under steady urging, then was taken in hand approaching the wire. CUBELET forced the pace between rivals to upper stretch, could not stay on terms with the winner but proved best of the rest. SCRATCH AGAIN stalked the leaders outside while making a mild rally into the stretch, and was forced to alter course in late stages. JESARAY chased the pace between rivals and came up empty. SO SPANISH saved ground throughout, while proving no threat. PEG'S PORSCHE pressed the pace three wide into the stretch, then drifted out sharply in the late stages. GLORIOUS JOY, allowed to settle saving ground, was no threat. HIGHBROOK BELLE showed little. EXCESSIVE SPEED ranged up dueling four wide into the turn, then drifted wide racing into the stretch. KEYHOLE LINDSEY, hard asked early, stopped badly.
