Footnotes

ROSIE'S RANSOM, caught in tight quarters at the start, secured a tracking position racing a bit off the inside to the backstretch, made steady progress nearing the far turn to split foes three deep on the bend, quickly took command in upper stretch and widened through the lane while being kept to the task. SHE FLOOR'D ME stalked the leaders in second flight along the inside to the far bend, came around a tiring rival to split foes in the lane and continued well to secure the place. NATURE COAST, unhurried in early stages tracking the leaders, came around foes on the far turn, angled out five deep nearing upper stretch and continued to improve position. SIPPIN' DEVIL, washy in the post parade, was brushed by FRENCHIE at the start, quickly sped to the fore along the inside, set the pace racing into upper stretch and weakened once headed by the winner. GREELEYSCHOICE ducked out at the start, was collected to track the leaders between foes in the last flight, then came out leaving the second bend to pass a few tiring rivals. MISS CREE, allowed to settle along the inside in the opening half, never gained striking distance. FRENCHIE broke inwards brushing SIPPIN' DEVIL and never threatened thereafter. LABELLUM stalked just off the pacesetter racing into the backstretch, pressed that rival approaching the far turn and gave way after six furlongs. SILVER RUCKUS tracked the leaders on the outside in second flight, couldn't produce the needed response on the second bend and faded steadily nearing the lane. CEEHAWK reared at the start and trailed the field.
