Footnotes

HUNTING PRINT sprinted clear soon after the start, settled on a long lead, then turned back a challenge through the second turn and drew off in the lane under steady handling. HIGH SPIRIT void of speed and inside, angled out through the second turn to bid four wide into the stretch, then closed well through the lane while no threat to the winner. BIG STICK tracked the pace on the inside, angled out into the second turn to challenged, could not go with the winner into the stretch, stayed on through the lane and weakened late. MERLE T tracked the pace on the inside, gained a striking position through the second turn, then lacked the needed late kick. VICTORY CHECK well back and inside, angled out in the stretch for clear racing room and passed tiring rivals. JONI'S JUSTICE hopped at the start, moved up quickly three wide, came four wide to bid into the stretch and faded. GREATSILVERSAINT well placed and outside, moved up three wide through the second turn, then had no rally. MING GLO was no factor, inside.
