MONSLEWN tracked the early pace off the rail, moved up three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, then made a steady gain, dueled late and edged ahead under a hand ride. MESA MIRAGE vied for the early lead outside, took command into the stretch, then dueled late with the winner and was outfinished. I'VE HEARD RUMORS void of speed and inside, angled out into the stretch to bid three wide, closed fast through the lane to get up for the show while no threat to the top two. GO DOLL well back and off the rail, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. AFLEETMOVINANGEL mid pack and inside, gained a striking position, then weakened the final furlong. WHY POLLY WHY set the early pace inside and faded in the drive. HELL 'N MAY showed little, outside. GYPSYFORTUNETELLER was through after a half.
