Footnotes

IFFAH (IRE) was rated in hand to the backstretch along the inside, came out a bit after a half while drawing into striking distance, split foes to challenge nearing mid stretch, bid inside ESKIMO BABY and just edged that foe under brisk handling. The latter, pulling hard early, angled outside foes on the backstretch while drawing on terms with the first flight, bid four wide through the far turn, gained a clear advantage between calls late but couldn't contain the winner. ARCH LADY, close up three wide in the opening stages, pressed the pace in that path to the far turn, held a brief lead leaving the second bend but proved no match for the top pair. HERROYALCRAZINESS, unhurried between foes in the opening half, split rivals leaving the far turn and continued to improve position late. T C'S CHERRY HILL stalked just off the leaders on the rail to the backstretch but came up empty on the far turn. CULLEY was hustled to the front along the rail, dueled for command to the far turn and gave way. APPLE'S DELIGHT engaged a rival for command soon after the start, pressed the pace to the far turn, then faded from contention. CANTA BONITA (ARG) was never a serious factor. CEEHAWK showed little.
