SHERGAR'S SPIRIT was urged to secure a tracking position in the second flight in the opening quarter, continued to make steady progress racing three deep into the bend to gain striking position, drew on terms with the pacesetter in upper stretch, wrested command and pulled away under some right handed pressure, then was taken in hand late. TONY NO SOCKS sprinted clear of the field from the break while angling to the inside, couldn't match the winner when challenged and was extended to save second. MUSIC TOPPER tracked the pace near the inside, saved ground to upper stretch and continued evenly for a share. BUGLIGHT was devoid of early speed, split foes racing into upper stretch and produced a late response to improve his position. ON SHAKY GROUND tracked the pacesetter as part of the second flight between foes racing to the turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. E FARLEY DUE raced unhurried along the inside early, made some mild progress after a half but came up empty in late stages. EARLY OUT EDDIE stalked

the pacesetter along the inside in second flight but faded steadily nearing the lane. JR HILLS was outpaced early and passed only tiring rivals. NOT SO TIMELESS never seriously menaced. ROSS THE BOSS dropped out early. JAYEMBRO was a brief factor between foes but gave way after a half.
