Footnotes

MOGADISHU well back and outside, moved up to loop rivals three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch, drifted in under left hand urging and drove clear late. NOT SO FAST FESTUS rated back nicely on the rail, moved up through the second turn, angled out to bid three wide into the stretch, then drifted out and back in through the lane and could not match the winners stride. JACK'S ROMA well back and inside, moved to a striking position through the second turn, angled out and bid three wide into the stretch, split rivals inside the eighth pole, clipped heels and held show. PROGRAM MANAGER set a pressured pace on the outside, dueled with QUICK SCORE through the lane and weakened late. QUICK SCORE vied for the early lead inside while pulling, edged ahead between calls, then dueled with PROGRAM MANAGER through the lane and faded in the late going. JOYFUL FRIEND mid pack and outside, moved up to a striking position through the turn, then had no rally. JOSIES DISTRACTION outrun. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY AND JOCKEYS OBJECTION RESULTED IN THE DISQUALIFICATION OF MOGADISHU FROM 1ST TO 2ND AND NOT SO FAST FESTUS FROM 2ND TO 3RD.
