Footnotes

MONA LISA LADY unhurried in second flight racing three wide to the backstretch, advanced four wide approaching the far turn to challenge for command, forged clear midway through the second bend, then widened her advantage while being kept to pressure. SOARING SKY, allowed to settle racing to the backstretch, split foes racing just off the inside on the far turn, came inside a rival to secure the place but couldn't gain terms with the winner. SILVER RUCKUS stalked the leaders in hand along the rail in the opening half, swung out midway through the far turn to challenge four wide in the lane but lacked the needed final kick. S TABLE DANCER was hustled to the front and angled to the rail on the first bend, briefly relinquished command on the backstretch, responded to pressure to take brief command racing into the far turn but gave way once headed by the winner. ASTUTA raced between foes in second flight to the far turn but lacked the necessary closing bid. NATURE COAST was a bit outpaced early and never gained striking distance. STORMY DAISY went up to prompt the pace three deep to the backstretch, then dropped out after a half. PRETTY GRITTY, a bit reluctant to load, was reserved saving ground to the backstretch, never seriously menaced and finished in hand in the final eighth. MAYBE NOT was sent hard between foes racing into the first turn, gave way after a half and was taken in hand nearing the furlong grounds.
