**Footnotes**

SHOPPERS SHUTTLE away well, dictated the tempo off the inside to the bend, forged clear in upper stretch and widened her margin under pressure. ELUSIVE WOLF stalked just off the pacesetter outside a rival racing into the bend, couldn't close the gap on that foe but was clearly second best. LAVEEN stumbled at the start, was allowed to collect herself, then came around foes racing through the lane to improve position. R J SOLO FLIGHT tracked the leaders off the inside into the turn but lacked the necessary closing response. A WHEATIES GIRL, close up along the inside in the opening stages, steadily faded from contention after a half. SMOKIN AFFAIR was never a factor.
