FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. Free to nominate, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start, with \$50,000 guaranteed, of which \$30,000 guaranteed to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. Weights: Three-year-olds, 116 lbs; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$15,000 twice in 2009 allowed 3 lbs; \$15,000 in 2009, 5 lbs; \$10,000 in 2008-2009, 7 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances). HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED. (On the scale). (Winners Preferred). Total earnings in 2008-2009 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, May 28 with 33. (If management deems it inadvisable to run this race on the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 1 Mile on the main track.) (Rail at 10 feet).

Footnotes

SPIDER POWER (IRE) was settled along the inside in the opening half, swung outside his entymate on the far turn while commencing his rally, was fanned six wide in upper stretch but continued with a determined effort to edge PURSUE A DREAM under brisk handling. The latter, reserved just off the inside racing to the far turn, continued near the inside to upper stretch, split foes while angling out five deep, contested the issue inside his entymate to the final stages but came up second best. KING A. J. broke out bumping GUN SALUTE at the break, was quickly righted while securing the lead along the rail, attended the pace under a rating hold racing to the far turn, went clear when given his cue in upper stretch, resisted the top pair to late stages but couldn't contain those foes. CANARD angled over to the rail early, saved ground under rating, then continued willingly in that path to the end. HEZA WILD GUY, reserved in hand tracking the leaders along the inside to the backstretch, shifted out nearing upper stretch but had no final bid. GUN SALUTE, bumped at the start, quickly recovered to attend the pace outside a rival, pressed that foe through the far turn and emptied out in the drive. CRIMSON KING CAT was a brief factor tracking the leaders as part of the second flight but faded steadily from contention nearing upper stretch.
