FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. Free to nominate, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start, with \$50,000 guaranteed, of which \$30,000 guaranteed to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. Weights: Three-year-olds, 116 lbs; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$15,000 twice in 2008 allowed 3 lbs; \$15,000 in 2008, 5 lbs; \$10,000 in 2007-2008, 7 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances). HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED. (On the scale). (Winners Preferred). Total earnings in 2007-2008 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, May 29 with 30. (If management deems it inadvisable to run this race on the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 1 Mile on the main track.).

Footnotes

PROSPECTIVE KISS was settled between foes in the opening stages, shifted out on the backstretch while readily advancing to contention approaching the far turn, lodged a three wide bid midway through the far turn, wrested command near midstretch and pulled clear under firm handling. SWITZERLAND, prominent along the inside from the outset, bid for command in tandem with the winner racing along the rail on the far turn, couldn't match that rival in the drive but was clearly best of the others. HEZA WILD GUY was settled along the inside early, swung out four wide leaving the far turn and made a sustained effort to secure a share in the final strides. TRAIL THIS broke sharply, disputed the pace between foes racing into the far turn, then gave way nearing upper stretch. WALLY'S CHOICE tracked the pace outside foes to the backstretch, was urged along to maintain terms with the eventual winner racing through the backstretch but came up empty on the far turn. VOY POR UNO MAS joined the pace racing three wide to the backstretch, dueled between foes entering the far turn, then dropped out nearing upper stretch.
