Footnotes

NOT SO FAST FESTUS, urged to a forward placing in the opening stages, tracked just off the leaders to the bend, angled out midway through the bend to lodge a three wide bid in upper stretch, wrested command leaving midstretch and went clear under firm encouragement. TUGFIRE allowed to settle between foes in the opening stages, swung five wide nearing upper stretch, split foes and continued with interest to secure the place. CORKSAPOPIN tracked just off and outside the leaders early, was caught four wide racing through the turn, then continued willingly in that path through the lane to gain a share. ENLISTEE broke readily, angled to the rail while dictating the pace, dueled inside a rival nearing upper stretch and weakened late. FRIENDLY FORCE tracked the leaders unhurried near the inside, then made some mild progress between foes racing through the stretch. BORN RUNNING angled inwards while securing terms with the pacesetter, attended that foe's tempo, pressed the issue on the bend, then faded in late stages. NOT SO TIMELESS was never a factor. JAYEMBRO angled outside foes to make a, brief, five wide bid but quickly emptied out. BEAVER LAKES BEST trailed.
