READY TO ROLL stalked the pace, raced four wide in the stretch and finished gamely to be clear under all out pressure. KNOW NO SOMERSET was bumped at the start, moved up five wide in the lane and made a good late bid. GHOST SKIER stalked the pace, took command nearing the far turn, built a clear lead and weakened in the latter stages. NICE TO MEET ME was unhurried early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and made a good late bid. SUPER DOCTOR was unhurried early, raced towards the inside and never was a real threat. MONDOVI broke in at the start, bumped rival, dropped back early and failed to have a response. VIC THE KICK stalked the pace and weakened. DESERT PRIZE pressed the pace and gave way. MUSICAL DEPUTY was slow early and never menaced. BEAR ISLAND was hard sent from the inside to press and tired. FRANCIS HENRY was bumped hard at the start and never threatened.
