**Footnotes**

RESTLESS WARRIOR stalked the pace on the outside, took command into the stretch, then held under steady pressure. MUCHNESS hopped at the start, moved up through the second turn inside, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then altered out for clear racing room and closed well to get up for the place in the final strides. BESAME VIDA mid pack and inside, moved up through the second turn, angled out to bid three wide into the stretch, then lacked the late kick needed and was outfinished for the place. SAPPHIRE SUE well placed and outside, came three wide to bid into the stretch and weakened in the drive. MANIAC MONROW tracked the pace on the rail while pulling, raced boxed into the stretch, steadied, then ran evenly through the lane. ALPHABETS TUFF GAL set the pace inside and flattened out. DROPPED CALL steadied into the first turn, was well placed and between rivals, came four wide to bid and had no stretch rally. TIGHTROPE DANCER improved her position. TRU OMEGA showed little. ANDREA'S JOSIE was no menace.
