Footnotes

PARKER COUNTY, prominent from the outset, angled to the rail while gaining a narrow advantage into the backstretch, set the pace to the lane, opened a clear margin in upper stretch, then held safe the late rally of MISS TWO BAGGER under steady pressure. MISS TWO BAGGER, allowed to settle along the rail in the opening stages, angled outside foes while commencing her rally three wide on the far turn, split foes entering the stretch, was getting to the winner while drifting inwards in late stages. MS FANCY PANTS was hustled from the break to force the pace three deep into the first turn, stalked the pacesetter through the backstretch, came under pressure to close the gap on the far turn, but soon proved no match and weakened through the lane. LILIAS LADY, close up in the early stages, dropped off the pace racing into the backstretch and never regained a contending position. CERISTIC, reserved in the early stages, raced four wide into the backstretch, made a mild bid in that path to the far turn but could not seriously threaten. ADAMS GLORY was under pressure from the outset to gain a contending position, was getting out a bit on the first turn and soon gave way. CROWNING GLORY was rushed racing four wide through the first turn to join the leaders, could not get on terms with the winner and gave way after a half. RUNRUBYRUN was off a step slow and could not produce a rally. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF MS FANCY PANTS LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST MISS TWO BAGGER WHICH WAS DISALLOWED.
