DIPLOMAT'S REWARD, unhurried tracking the leaders from the outside in early stages, worked his way to the rail on the backstretch, steadily gained terms with RETAIN to challenge inside that foe leaving the far turn and pulled clear under firm pressure. The latter went quickly to the front, attended the pace inside a rival to the far turn, dispatched that rival between calls leaving the far bend, was no match for the winner but grudgingly held for second. EBISU (GER), reluctant to load, made steady progress outside foes to gain striking position nearing the lane but couldn't sustain that effort in the last quarter. IT'S TRULY OBVIOUS raced unhurried in early stages while between foes, came under pressure to advance but couldn't produce a closing bid. FOURTH ACT tracked the pace between foes along the inside and passed a few tiring rivals in the latter stages. UNTRACEABLE was never a serious factor. AIR FORBES ACADEMY saved ground to the backstretch and soon faded. NICKEL, reserved to the backstretch, offered no rally. DONTHELUMBERTRADER, forwardly placed from the break, closed the gap on the first flight nearing the far turn but faltered in the drive. BERRY BID was hustled to the front, forced the tempo to the far turn and soon stopped.
