Footnotes

BLAST'EM well back and inside, gained position on the two path through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch, then closed fast to get up in the final strides. HOP ALONG HARRY well back and outside, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid, then made a steady gain in the lane and could not match the winners stride late. HYPE sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, turned back a challenged into the stretch, shook clear and was outfinished. GOLD COUNTRY CAT tracked the pace on the inside, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then lacked the needed late kick. KEEN BIDDER (GB) moved up quickly to be well placed outside, came four wide to bid into the stretch, steadied and weakened in the drive. COURAGEOUS CAREY well placed and outside, bid three wide, angled in for clear racing room and faded in the drive. BROKEANDBUSTED stalked the pace outside and had no stretch rally. GEOCACHE was a brief factor. FLEET CAVALRY was never involved.
