### Footnotes

DAKOTA DIGGER vied for the early lead outside, moved up to edged ahead quickly, then drove clear the final furlong and held under brisk handling. DON'T BLUFF mid pack and between rivals, moved to position on the two path through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch, then closed well through the lane and missed. GRANDPA ROY well placed and inside, gained a striking position through the second turn, angled out to bid three wide, then lacked the needed late kick. SURPLUS set the early pace inside, stayed with the winner to the final furlong and weakened. HIGH SPIRIT well back and inside, passed tiring rivals. SAMENDRA mid pack and outside, moved up through the second turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch and ran evenly the final furlong. TUBBY TIME showed little. BRAVO PRADO mid pack and outside, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid, steadied in the lane and faded. BLADE SCUFFLER well placed and inside, moved up on the two path through the second turn, came four wide to bid and faltered. TOO BOLD TO HOLD was outrun.
