Footnotes

BEAT YOUR BLUFF set the pace on the inside, turned back a challenged through the second turn, then dueled with HOLIDAY BUZZ through the lane and edged ahead in the final strides. HOLIDAY BUZZ well placed and off the rail, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, dueled with the winner and hung. SWIFT PROGRESS well back and inside, gained position through the second turn, was blocked into the stretch, got through between rivals, then lacked the needed late kick. PERSHING tracked the pace on the inside, angled out into the stretch, exchanged bumps with a rival and weakened. JACK AND MAX stalked the pace on the outside, moved up to bid just outside the pace, exchanged bumps with a rival and could not rally. DIXIE BUCK was never involved. PECKINPAH was a brief factor.
