RITA'S CHEETAH well placed and inside, gained position through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drove clear late. MANE SLICK sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, held through the late going and was outfinished by the winner late while clearly best of the rest. NABISCO CAT stalked the early pace three wide, took back into the turn and angled in, moved up and came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then ran evenly through the lane. CINDER ELLIE well placed and four wide, gained position through the turn, bid on the same path into the stretch and weakened the final furlong. STORMY TARA improved her position. MOLLY MCCRACKEN ran evenly. TRICKSTER'S QUEEN passed tiring rivals. SAM LORD'S BELLE showed little. DANCEHALL ROXIE was a brief factor, inside.
