BLACK LOTUS prompted the pace outside, drew clear the into stretch and powered away under a steady drive. JAN'S PRINCESS settled inside just off the leaders, swung three wide while advancing leaving the turn and continued well to prove second best. EXTRA CREDIT angled outside on the backstretch and raced five wide into the stretch. OLE' ANGEL broke sharply, then angled inwards to set the pace into the turn, weakened once headed. GLORIOUSLY flashed brief pace between rivals and faded leaving the turn. THE GREAT INNATE shied from ANGEL CAROL at the break, switched to the rail for racing room, but proved no threat. Highbrook Belle pressed the pace racing nearest the rail and gave way entering the turn. ANGEL CAROL shifted in at the start, then proved no menace while ducking from the sloppy going. MAYOR MARY, slow into stride, raced six wide to the turn and came up empty. R. G. WILDCARD was quickly outpaced.
