**Footnotes**

HERE COMES HENRY shifted outwards at the start while under pressure to gain position with the first flight, disputed the pace racing along the rail into the bend, edged clear in upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. PIOUS PETE, caught in close quarters and bumped at the start, quickly recovered to track just off the first flight along the inside racing to the bend, angled out three deep entering upper stretch to challenge, couldn't gain terms with the winner but continued well enough to save second. MACK'S BLACKHAWK broke in, bumping ROOT RIVER KID, was quickly righted to gain a contending position, raced four wide into upper stretch while continuing willingly but was outfinished for the place. SOMERSET IMAGE angled sharply to the rail in the opening quarter, saved ground to upper stretch while gaining terms with the second flight but had no final response. WIDE IDE prompted the pace between foes from the outset, pressed the winner to upper stretch and gave way. WHY I'M RED, crowded a bit at the start, was righted to chase the pace between foes to the turn but lacked the needed late response. HUEBAKER broke in, bumped VALENTINE HARRY, was caught wide throughout and proved no factor. TIN CAN DO exchanged bumps with PIOUS PETE at the start, settled collecting his stride, then passed some tiring rivals in late stages. VALENTINE HARRY, bumped at the start, was quickly righted, raced five wide into the turn while tracking just off the leaders but faded steadily after a half. TIMBER HILLS was a brief factor racing four wide between foes but retreated nearing the lane. ROOT RIVER KID, bumped at the start by MACK'S BLACKHAWK, never menaced thereafter. TIOGA CROSSING showed little.
