SLEEZEE MISS set a pressured pace on the inside, dueled to the eighth pole with MALAWI, shook clear late and drew off while being kept to the task. MALAWI vied for the lead on the outside, dueled to the eight pole with the winner, then tired. MARINA NOLAN broke a step slowly, was well back and outside, fanned four wide to bid into the stretch, then made a steady gain through the lane and missed the place in the final strides. SNEAKY IRISH LASS mid pack and inside early, moved up on the rail, then drifted out slightly in the lane and ran evenly late. MUSICAL SHARON improved her position inside. VALID MOM showed little, three wide. MISS BABY BENTON was no factor, widest. RIO BRILLA chased the pace on the rail and faded after a half.
