Footnotes

ERV THE BANKER stalked the early pace three wide, moved up on that path through the second turn, angled in slightly to bid just outside the pace, then dueled with KELEYS MARQ to the final furlong and drove clear under brisk handling. KELLEYS MARQ tracked the early pace inside while pulling, was forced to steady off heels through the first turn, then settled down the backstretch, angle out to bid three wide into the stretch, dueled with the winner and could not match stride while clearly best of the rest. DOS ANGELS WARRIOR well back and off the rail, gained a striking position through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch and could not gain the final furlong. TRICKY SKY PILOT vied for the early lead outside, gained a short lead through the second turn, then weakened in the drive. LAUNCH N LUKE improved his position. KENSINGTON STONE passed tiring rivals. BALL AND CRANE was a brief factor. THREE DESPERADOES set the early pace inside, stopped and was eased over the wire.
