MISTER MERZ rated back inside, gained position through the second turn, angled out slightly in the stretch, took command when ask and drew off the final furlong. SLEW CITY STORM tracked the early pace on the inside, angled out and moved up three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch and held the place while no threat to the winner. PIONEER EDITION mid pack and on the rail, angled out to loop rivals three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch, then closed well and missed the place in the final strides. CODE RUNNER mid pack and inside, angled out four wide into the stretch, then closed well through the lane to get up for a share. ILIKECHOCOLATEMILK void of speed and off the rail, improved his position. FLEET CAVALRY passed tiring rivals. SUBTLE HUNTER set the early pace outside, gained a clear lead and faded the final furlong. FIESTY FITZ vied inside and stopped. AZA showed little.
