SWEET FLEET FEET chased the early pace on the rail, challenged for and gained a clear lead into the stretch, then lasted. MOGADISHU void of speed and on the rail, moved up through the second turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then angled out for clear racing room, closed willing and missed in the final strides. ROUNDUP MOMENT mid pack and on the rail, angled out into the stretch to bid four wide, then lacked the needed late response. SUNSET KID stalked the early pace three wide, then had no rally. MATT N MITCH moved up and bid five wide, then had no response. FRIENDLY FORCE set the early pace off the rail and weakened. DOCTOR CLICK stalked the early pace three wide and faded nearing the lane.
