MARCH TWELTH pressed the pace, gained command nearing the turn and held gamely to be clear under strong pressure. SEVEN TORRENTS showed good speed from the inside and finished second best. DUKE DELUXE was unhurried early, saved ground throughout and finished willingly to the wire. MARATHON MOON stalked the pace from the outside, raced four wide in the stretch and weakened a bit in the final stages. RUSTIC ROAD dropped back early, raced three wide and had no response. SUNSET KID was squeezed back at the start and never was a factor. NOT SO FAST FESTUS failed to menace. SUGARDAZZLE failed to sustain a bid.
