QUOTE TO CASH chased the early pace on the inside, moved up through the second turn, angled out to bid outside the pace setter, then made a steady gain and edged ahead in the final strides. LAMBDA NU set the pace on the inside, increased his margin throughout and was outfinished while clearly best of the rest. LUXURY AND GLITTER mid pack and outside, moved up on the two path through the second turn, came three wide to bid and could not gain the final furlong. ARVINDRA well placed and inside, came through inside of rival into the stretch and ran evenly. RAGGED EDGE bumped and squeezed into the first turn, was well placed inside, bid three wide into the stretch and weakened in the drive. MAN OF DUBAI improved his position. THEPOINTMAN bumped hard into the first turn, was shuffled back and was no factor. GOVERNMENTFAILURE was a brief factor. ETHAN DAVID had an awkward start and was outrun.
