### Footnotes

BOBBLE DOIT never far back and outside, moved up three wide through the turn, fanned widest into the stretch, then made a steady gain and edged ahead in the final strides. SUPREMO STRUCKGOLD never far back and inside, moved to position through the turn, angled out slightly to bid between rivals into the stretch, then gained a short lead inside the final furlong and was outfinished. MUSICAL DEPUTY set the early pace four wide, dropped back slightly into the stretch, came again in the late going to hold the show safe. LIONS COURT vied for the early lead from between rivals, angled in into the turn, gained a short lead in the stretch and weakened in the drive. BOLD RAIDER well placed and outside, looped rivals four wide through the turn, came five wide to bid into the stretch and ran evenly in the lane. BEAR ISLAND ran evenly. PRINCE DEMIDOFF well back and off the rail, bid three wide and lost ground. MAHARAJA improved his position. KIPSON showed little. SHEER TRICK was never involved. APPEALS THE DEAL stalked the pace inside and was through after a half. SLYDING BY was a brief factor and was outrun.
