SUGAR STORM stalked the pace from the outside, raced three deep and drew off in the final stages to be well clear under steady pressure. REDNECK RICHIE pressed the pace, raced towards the inside and was no match for the winner. SEATTLE SAL stalked the pace, raced four deep and had no final bid. HI PRIM was unhurried early, moved up five wide into the lane and had no final bid. TYMAKER raced six wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. ALEX'S TOMCAT failed to respond. FLAMING GLORY was slow early and never menaced. CORNETTO vied for the lead along the inside and tired. WIRELESS MACHO showed little. PECKINPAH failed to sustain a bid.
