Footnotes

FASTYBUTNASTY tracked the leaders racing in the second flight, rallied on the turn while splitting foes into the lane, then wore down PIZZAZZ under brisk right handed pressure. The latter made a steady advance along the rail to challenge the pacesetter, forged clear in upper stretch, but could not contain the winner's late bid. RED CLAY CYDDY was hustled hard outside rivals to secure a position, chased the pace through the turn, then weakened into the stretch. SALTY MAUD was roused to the lead between foes, set the pace into the bend and gave way once headed. KATIN broke outwards brushing RED CLAY CYDDY, then lost position and could produce no rally. PRETTY LILLY, unprepared at the start, raced wide and offered no rally. ZOUCHA NUTCRACKER stalked the leaders along the inside to the turn, soon came up empty and was not abused in late stages.
