STAKES Canterbury Park Oaks Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. \$25 to nominate, \$200 to pass the entry box and \$200 additional to start, with \$40,000 guaranteed, of which \$24,000 guaranteed to the owner of the winner, \$8,000 to second, \$4,400 to third, \$2,400 to fourth and \$1,200 to fifth. Weight: 120 lbs. Winners of a sweepstakes in 2002 to carry an additional 2 lbs. Non-winners of three races other than maiden or claiming allowed 2 lbs; of two races other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs; a race other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs; Maidens, 8 lbs. SARAH JADE went clear of her rivals in the opening quarter while well within herself, made her own pace to the far bend, drifted off the inside in upper stretch, was roused to extend her margin leaving the three sixteenths marker and widened her advantage to the end under energetic handling. GIST shifted inwards at the start, was quickly righted to stalk the pace in reserve along the rail to the backstretch, came through inside foes on the far bend to challenge, couldn't maintain terms with the winner through the lane but stubbornly prevailed for second. DON'T COUNTESS OUT was rated just off the pacesetter while dropping over to the inside on the first turn, came out a bit to briefly challenge that rival midway through the far turn but faded in the drive. AGGIES STYLE, allowed to settle along the rail in the opening quarter, made an effort to improve her position leaving the second turn. PERSIMMON RIDGE tracked just outside the leaders racing to the backstretch, briefly advanced to challenge approaching the far turn but gave way leaving the three eighths marker. PRAIRIE VIEW was caught outside foes racing into the first turn and soon dropped out. OUR COLUMBINE, reserved in hand between foes in the opening stages, faded steadily from contention after a half.
