Footnotes

BALI CRUISE drifted very wide racing into the first turn, was collected to make steady progress inside foes on the backstretch, rallied to contention saving ground on the second bend, came out to split foes and challenge for command leaving midstretch and held ACADEMIC LASS safe under firm handling. The latter rated in hand tracking the leaders to the backstretch, briefly awaited an opening on the far turn, bid five wide for command racing into the lane and was outkicked. CRAFTY MEME, forwardly placed stalking the pacesetter, closed the gap on that foe racing into the lane but was no match for the top pair. DANSE KONGO sped clear of the field racing to the first turn, dictated the pace to midstretch but failed to sustain her momentum. WHO'S THE FOX raced unhurried saving ground to the far turn, swung out entering the lane but had no final kick. STREAKINJEB, reserved saving ground in the opening half, passed some tiring rivals in late stages. SEATTLE AFTERNOON tracked just off the pacesetter along the inside to the far turn but faded steadily in the drive. CLAIRE BLACK was never in contention. SNOW DEVIL tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight for a half, then gave way on the far turn. DREAM PRINCESS never seriously menaced. TOKIN N JOKIN was a brief factor racing four wide to the backstretch but gave way abruptly on the far turn.
