Footnotes

MINNESOTA SLEW, off a bit awkwardly, was settled in hand while working his way to the inside, made some progress to gain contention leaving the turn, came out four deep nearing midstretch to challenge outside the first flight, took over in the final stages under some right handed pressure, then drifted in approaching the wire . POLISHED BRITELY, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground stalking just off the first flight, then came inside those foes in the final stages to secure second. TEZ AZADI joined the pace between foes soon after the start, dueled for command racing into upper stretch, weakened late and was steadied a bit avoiding the winner in the final strides. BORN RUNNING broke sharply, vied for command three deep racing to the turn, couldn't match the winner's bid and weakened in the drive. JAGAN broke out, bumped TRICKY TITAN, was settled outside foes racing to the bend and never gained contention. KAOS KID ducked out at the start, was quickly collected, then hustled to contention racing four wide into the turn, but gave way after a half. LOWELL DEAN never mounted a serious challenge. TRICKY TITAN stumbled, then was bumped at the start, recovered to be a brief factor outside foes but faded steadily nearing the lane. FEUDAL CAT broke slowly and never menaced thereafter. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF TEZ AZADI LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER WHICH WAS DISALLOWED.
