LITTLE WAGON was reserved outside foes in the opening half, rallied smartly four deep on the far turn to gain terms with the leaders entering upper stretch, wrested command from the pacesetter leaving the furlong marker and held safe the challenge of ONOTHEREGOSTOKYO under firm handling. The latter was devoid of early speed, tracked just inside the winner to the backstretch, advanced to contention in tandem with that rival leaving the far turn, split foes three deep in the lane to challenge for command but was outfinished. REALITY MOUNTAIN went readily to the fore, attended the pace outside a rival for five furlongs, edged forward nearing midstretch but proved no match for the top pair. DEPUTY TICE was settled in hand in early stages, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. MIGHTY TUK, reserved saving ground to the backstretch, came out after a half while gaining a striking position but lacked the needed closing bid. CASTLES IN THE SKY was rated saving ground in the opening half, briefly awaited an opening on the far turn while remaining nearest the rail, came inside foes entering the lane but had no final response. ASHE'S CAT sprinted to the lead along the inside from the break, dueled for command racing into the far turn, then gave way in the drive. NORTHCOUNTRY CHIEF tracked just off the first flight while steadily working his way to the inside but faded in the drive. CALEB BOY was caught four wide racing into the first turn, made a brief bid on the far turn and quickly dropped out.
