CORPORATE CHARLIE sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, increased his margin while never being challenged and drew off in the lane under steady pressure. MIGUEL BABY stalked the pace outside, moved up through the turn to bid four wide into the stretch, then duelled the final furlong with RESLEY CREEK and edged ahead in the final strides. RESLEY CREEK tracked the pace off the rail, angled out through the turn and bid three wide into the stretch, duelled the final furlong and missed the place. UNCHAIN THE TRAIN rushed up inside, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then lacked the needed late kick. RED ROCK BAY showed little, outside. DOUBLE TALL was never involved.
