AMBASSADOR OF WAR stalked the early pace, made a bid in the backstretch, dueled with the front runner, took command heading into the stretch and steadily drew clear. HAVA CIGAR settled in near the back of rivals early, made a bid leaving the backstretch and rallied to get up for place. EIGHTEEN WHEELS stalked the pace along the inside, made a bid along the rail heading for home and failed to kick on in the late drive. MAJ'R RULER took command early, dueled with rival in the backstretch and could not keep up the pace in the stretch drive. GREAT EXUMA stalked the early pacesetters and lacked a late kick to make an impact. TRIPPIN WITH TAY made a bid in the early going and steadily weakened. ACROSS TIME failed to be a threat. RIVER DANCE showed little throughout.
