HUSTLER shifted in at the start and was quickly righted while hustled to the front between rivals, took command entering the backstretch, responded gamely to the challenge of YOTO SPEAKES and held that rival safe under steady pressure. The latter was in contact with the leaders from the outset, raced four wide into the first bend while securing a stalking position, angled inwards to track just off and outside the pacesetter on the backstretch, increased the tempo after a half to get on terms with the winner but proved second best in the drive. THATSUSINTHEOLBEAN stalked the leaders unhurried along the rail into the first turn, lost some position when shuffled back entering the far turn, then angled outside rivals entering the stretch to make a five wide belated rally. BALKO BAY angled inwards to gain a contending position stalking just off the leaders between rivals on the first bend, raced unhurried to the far turn, was switched outside while roused to challenge the leaders in upper stretch but made only a mild gain. MR. DI MARCO, reserved on the first turn while angling outside rivals, made a brief bid into the far turn but could not sustain his effort in the final quarter. CLEAT was taken in hand soon after the break while racing four wide into the first turn, exchanged brushes with CLOUDMAN entering the backstretch, shifted outside that foe nearing the far turn and drifted out in the final stages. CLOUDMAN was shuffled back at the start, raced five wide on the first turn while exchanging brushes with CLEAT, then continued four wide on the far bend while never a real factor. CASH DIVIDEND broke inwards at the start, bumping WOODS, was then steadied and never mounted a serious challenge thereafter. WOODS, bumped at the start, was collected and rushed to briefly set the pace along the rail and stopped nearing the far turn.
