COLUMBIA FALLS mid pack and on the rail, moved up through the turn, angled out to bid three wide into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drove clear late. TIGER'S VICTORY void of speed, moved up on the two path through the turn, angled out to bid four wide, then closed willingly to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. PRAIRIE VISION well back and off the rail, looped three wide through the turn, angled in in the stretch for racing room and closed well. TIME TAMER well placed and on the rail, angled out into the turn to move up three wide, came four wide into the stretch and weakened in the drive. LADY'S EDITION sent from the gate to set the pace off the rail, gained a clear lead into the stretch and faded in the drive. SOPHIE'SHOPE vied for the early lead inside and had no rally. SALARIANA stalked the early pace three wide and faltered. GALWAY MOON was never involved, outside.
