CARSON'S HONOR rated nicely on a clear lead, increased his margin while never challenged and was ridden out. ALERIC chased the winner off the rail, closed willingly through the lane but could not threaten the winner. LITTLE WAGON well back and inside, angled out to loop rivals four wide through the second turn, then had a steady gain in the lane and got up for the show late. RATE OF CHANGE mid pack and inside, exchanged bumps into the second turn while boxed, found room into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. SMUGGLER'S HOLD stalked the pace three wide and weakened in the drive. TIGER BUD passed a tiring rival in the lane. SOMMELIER SMARTY well placed on the rail, faded in the drive. PLATINUM DEVIL had a wide trip and was no factor.
