Footnotes

MYWAY HOME stalked just off and outside the leaders racing through the backstretch, rallied to the front racing four deep through the turn, then prevailed in the late stages after a prolonged drive. CENTER POINT BLAZE, allowed to settle along the inside racing into the turn, swung out in upper stretch and continued with a belated bid to secure the place. PRADO'S DREAM made a steady advance on the leaders through the backstretch, pressed the pace three wide between foes to upper stretch, couldn't match the winner in the last eighth and weakened late. SILENT SWEEP prompted the pace between foes into the turn and gave way nearing mid stretch. BELLE AMERICAN tracked the leaders between foes racing to the bend, angled out nearing upper stretch but had no late response. FROSTY PROSPECTOR was caught six wide racing through the backstretch, tracked the leaders outside foes to the lane but never seriously threatened. CLASSY CON, pinched back at the start, dropped well back off her rivals racing through the backstretch, then made some late progress along the rail in the lane. TIMBIA was hustled up the rail from the break to dictate the pace, dueled inside foes through the turn but gave way abruptly after a half.
