Footnotes

AKINS ALIBI exchanged bumps with a rival at the start, was righted to track the leaders four wide in second flight through the backstretch, swung out nearing the quarter pole to challenge four wide, wrested command in the furlong grounds and went clear late under a drive. NOTE D'OR tracked the pace unhurried along the rail to the bend, angled out nearing the lane while making steady progress, continued five deep in the lane and just secured second late. CRAFTY CHARM dueled for command inside a rival racing to the turn, continued willingly into the lane but was no match for the winner. SCHEDULED FLIGHT angled inwards, prompted the pace three wide racing into the turn, gained a brief advantage in upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. MISS WHITNEY broke sharply, forced the pace between foes, dueled into upper stretch and gave way. LODES OF CLASS exchanged bumps with the winner at the start, recovered to track between foes on the backstretch, angled inwards on the bend but lacked the necessary final bid. MIZIMOON tracked the leaders in second flight along the rail but couldn't produce the necessary late response. SWEET NIJINSKY never gained striking distance. ORPHAN TINKA bumped by CHROMENALL at the start, was caught wide to the turn and never menaced. CHROMENALL broke in, bumped a rival and never threatened thereafter. MAYBE NOT was caught in tight quarters at the start and quickly dropped out. LACY ROSE gave way abruptly.
