JUST PLAIN JESSIE broke sharply, was held up just off the pace stalking the leaders, advanced readily while still in hand to join the pacesetter leaving the bend, took command and quickly drew clear through the lane under some left handed prompting. OFFSHORE NEWS went up to dispute the pace outside a rival, shook clear nearing the lane but proved no match for the winner. SNOW DEVIL made steady progress racing four wide to the lane but proved no match for the top pair. HOLY BIRD tracked the pace between foes just off the inside, came out five wide in the lane and continued to improved position. SHE AIN'T MUCH raced unhurried along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch and passed between some tiring rivals in the drive. CHAKALAKA BABY broke inwards bumping WINE EXPRESS, was righted to make some progress four wide on the turn, but flattened out in the drive. PARKLANE OAK faded steadily from contention. WINE EXPRESS, bumped at the start, never gained contention. SCRUB CAT was hustled along from the break, disputed the pace inside a rival but was through after a half. DESTINY AND ROSES was caught five wide throughout and offered no rally. NEILY BOP soon dropped out.
