MOMENTS FROM GLORY, unhurried in early stages, tracked the leaders from the outside to the backstretch, slowly drew on terms with the first flight entering the far bend, angled five wide leaving the quarter pole, collared FAPPOLINO in mid stretch and prevailed under pressure. The latter, reserved saving ground to the backstretch, split foes rallying to contention while shifting out midway through the far turn, lodged a four deep bid to go clear between calls but couldn't contain the winner. EASTER SAGA, in hand saving ground in the opening quarter, closed the gap on the leaders in tandem with the winner nearing the far turn, waited a bit for an opening leaving the second bend, then made an effort to improve her position while being guided outside in the drive. SMOKIN AFFAIR stalked just off the pacesetter to the backstretch, advanced to press the tempo three wide into the far turn, struck the front nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the lane. HELPFUL HINT advanced along the inside to gain terms with the pacesetter, forced the issue to the far turn and gave way. DEANNA M went quickly to the fore, made the pace between foes into the far turn and gave way after six furlongs. QUEEN'S CAPER was through early.
