HOLIDAY FLIGHT pressed the pace from the outside, gained command and drew off in the final stages under strong handling. MR. HOLLYWOOD stalked the pace, moved up along the inside and finished second best. FISKEY settled off the early pace, raced four wide in the stretch and had no late winning bid. FAIR TRADE was bumped at the start, raced four deep and never was a serious threat. JOG stalked the pace, raced four wide in the stretch and weakened the final eighth of a mile. PROUD BULL stalked the pace, bore out around the turn to the eight path and never menaced thereafter. INDY N MISSION was bumped at the start, saved ground and never was a factor. ITZA TWISTER failed to respond. PORT HRISHI trailed throughout.
