Footnotes

SILVER TRIPPI broke outwards momentarily impeding ROSES 'N RAINBOWS, was quickly collected to join the pace racing four wide between foes, shook clear on the turn, then steadily widened her advantage in a ridden out performance. MISS PRAVDA, off slowly, tracked the leaders just off the inside racing to the turn, was shuffled a bit in traffic approaching the bend, angled outside rivals entering the lane and continued to make steady progress to secure second in late stages. CRYPTIC AFFAIR, in close attendance to the pace while five deep in early stages, chased the winner outside foes to upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with that foe and weakened in the drive. GRANDIF joined the pace between foes soon after the break, couldn't match the winner's tempo after three furlongs but continued willingly to improve her placing. SAINT TERESA raced close up along the inside in the opening quarter, but steadily faded on the turn. ROSES 'N RAINBOWS, caught in tight quarters at the start, was collected to track just off the first flight three or four wide on the backstretch, split foes to make a brief bid on the turn but quickly flattened out. DELAVERNE SQUARE vied between foes near the inside racing to the bend but dropped out after a half. SHERSDANZING never seriously menaced. HUBBETT, off a bit awkwardly, lost position and never menaced thereafter.
