### Footnotes

IN HEAVEN was settled outside foes in the opening stages, made steady progress after a half to gain striking position, swung five wide entering upper stretch and continued with a sustained response to take charge late and draw clear under firm encouragement. PEACE OF THE WAGER raced unhurried tracking the leaders early, angled four wide entering upper stretch to challenge between foes, couldn't match terms with the winner but prevailed for the place. WAY UP THERE joined the pace outside a rival, dueled for command into upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the top pair but saved third. FREAKIN' OUT was hustled to the lead, dueled along the rail to upper stretch and emptied out in late stages. CANDIQUIK, reserved in hand while guided to the inside early, made some mild progress on the bend but had no final response. MIZ DAYJUR, caught six wide between foes early, never seriously menaced. SHES UH SECRET was caught five deep between foes in the opening quarter and dropped out early. TOWN SCANDAL stalked just off the leaders racing into the turn but steadily retreated in the drive. WORK IN PROGRESS dropped out early.
