Footnotes

HOPETOWN HERO sprinted to the lead along the inside from the break, dictated the tempo to the bend, turned back a rival leaving midstretch and edged clear under pressure. WALTER, close up three wide in early stages, challenged the winner racing into upper stretch but came up second best. CAPTAIN CANAVERAL tracked just off the leaders saving ground and continued evenly through the stretch to gain a share. CARTER HALL ducked out at the start, was righted to track the leaders from the outside, angled four wide entering upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. MINNESOTA SLEW was allowed to settle well off the pace, swung five wide racing into the lane but made no impression on the leaders. SMART TIME went up to prompt the pace outside the winner but gave way after three furlongs. SIR DOW JONES trailed.
