Footnotes

SKIPPY DIPPIN' stalked just off the leaders racing along the inside, came out nearing the lane while making steady progress, collared the pacesetter in late stages and wrested command in time. SAMISLEW broke sharply, dueled for command inside a rival, edged clear leaving midstretch and just failed to contain the winner. CAUSING GRIEF tracked the pace between foes, continued willingly while splitting the rivals nearing upper stretch and improved position to the end. SUDDENLY SILVER, off slowly, came around foes to gain contention racing five wide to upper stretch and was making progress to the end. CLASSIC TANAGER joined the pace outside a rival, dueled for command into upper stretch, then weakened late. COAL FIRE broke in, bumped FULLABEANS, was righted to track the pace between foes and continued evenly to late stages. ABIT O IRISH tracked the pace outside foes, made a brief, four wide bid leaving the turn and flattened out in the drive. BETTING LADD chased the leaders outside a rival to upper stretch and gave way in the drive. HURRY'S FIGHTER tracked the leaders along the inside to upper stretch but couldn't produce the necessary closing bid. GOTASHOTOFGOLD flashed brief pace, was steadied sharply in the opening furlong and never menaced thereafter. BOLD BULLDOG ducked in at the start, came under pressure early to gain contention but lacked the needed response. FULLABEANS was bumped at the start and never menaced thereafter.
