Footnotes

TRICKY SKY PILOT sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, was never challenged, drew off in the lane while being ridden out. SIR GHAZI well back and inside, gained a striking position through the second turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then closed willingly to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. LUCKY STRAW hard to rate inside, tracked the pace, angled out into the stretch to bid, then weakened in the drive. DOS ANGELS WARRIOR well placed and inside, passed a tiring rivals through the lane. NOBODYS BUFFOON stalked the pace outside and had no stretch rally. PONIBOY TIME was never involved. LUVIN' GEORGE was no factor.
